(F) TRANSFER OF EXCESS MONEY TO GENERAL FUND.

ON JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE SECRETARY SHALL DIRECT THE STATE TREASURER TO TRANSFER TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE THE BALANCE IN THE SPECIAL ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE FUND THAT:

- (1) THE SECRETARY HAS NOT ALLOCATED, AND
- (2) EXCEEDS \$250,000.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language added to state expressly that which only was implied in the former law. This addition is supported by the first sentence of former Art. 95A, § 14(c), which created the Special Administrative Expense Fund "in the State Treasury".

Subsections (b) through (d) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from the third, eleventh, twelfth, and fourteenth sentences of former Art. 95A, § 14(c) and the thirteenth sentence as that sentence related to availability of the fund.

In subsection (b) of this section, the reference to access "whenever [money] is needed" is substituted for the former reference to access "continuously", to conform to $\S 8-415(c)$ of this subtitle. The word "continuously" seemed to refer back to the status of the fund as a "nonlapsing fund". See $\S 8-420(b)(1)$ of this subtitle.

In subsection (e) of this section, the reference to "office space" is substituted for the former references to "land and/or buildings acquired for its use" and "space used by the Secretary" to conform to § 8–421(c), which limits acquisition of "land", "buildings", and other "space" to "office space".

As to the limitations on use of money in the Special Administrative Expense Fund for office space, see § 8-421(c) of this subtitle.
