8-503. QUORUM; COMPENSATION; STAFF.

(A) OUORUM.

TWO MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF APPEALS SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM. A VACANCY DOES NOT IMPAIR THE RIGHT OF THE REMAINING MEMBERS TO EXERCISE THE POWERS OF THE BOARD OF APPEALS UNDER THIS TITLE.

(B) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF APPEALS IS ENTITLED TO THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

- (C) STAFF.
- (1) SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF APPEALS, THE SECRETARY SHALL APPOINT THE NUMBER OF HEARING EXAMINERS AND OTHER PERSONNEL THAT THE BOARD OF APPEALS NEEDS FOR EFFECTIVE AND PROPER PERFORMANCE OF THE APPEALS PROCEDURES UNDER THIS TITLE.
- (2) THE SECRETARY SHALL HAVE ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY OVER ALL PERSONNEL.
 - (D) EQUIPMENT; OFFICES; SERVICES; SUPPLIES.

THE SECRETARY SHALL PROVIDE THE BOARD OF APPEALS WITH THE OFFICES, EQUIPMENT, SERVICES, AND SUPPLIES NECESSARY FOR ITS OPERATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 95A, § 11(a) and the sixth through eighth sentences of (b).

In subsection (a) of this section, the former provision that "[n]o vacancy shall impair the right of the remaining members to exercise the powers" of the Board of Appeals is deleted as unnecessary in light of the reference to members "then serving" on the Board of Appeals.

In subsection (b)(1) of this section, the reference to "the salary provided in the State budget" is substituted for the former reference to "remuneration in such amount or amounts as may be fixed by the Standard Salary Board", to
