8-626. CONTRIBUTION AND EMPLOYMENT REPORTS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

FOR EACH CALENDAR QUARTER, EACH EMPLOYING UNIT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY A CONTRIBUTION AND EMPLOYMENT REPORT ON OR BEFORE THE DATE THAT THE SECRETARY SETS.

(B) CONTENTS.

AN EMPLOYING UNIT SHALL INCLUDE IN A CONTRIBUTION AND EMPLOYMENT REPORT INFORMATION THAT THE SECRETARY REQUIRES.

(C) PENALTY.

AN EMPLOYING UNIT THAT FAILS TO SUBMIT A CONTRIBUTION OR EMPLOYMENT REPORT UNDER THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A PENALTY OF \$35 UNLESS THE SECRETARY WAIVES THE PENALTY FOR CAUSE.

8-627. SEPARATION NOTICES.

(A) REPORTS ON INDIVIDUAL CASES.

- (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION, ON REQUEST OF THE SECRETARY, AN EMPLOYING UNIT SHALL PROVIDE TO THE SECRETARY A REPORT OF THE SEPARATION FROM EMPLOYMENT OF AN INDIVIDUAL.
- (2) AN EMPLOYING UNIT WHO SUBMITS A SEPARATION NOTICE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL:
- (I) COMPLETE THE NOTICE ON A FORM OR IN A MANNER THAT THE SECRETARY REQUIRES; AND
- (II) SUBMIT THE NOTICE NO LATER THAN THE 4TH BUSINESS DAY AFTER THE DAY OF THE REQUEST.
