

(E) DISQUALIFICATION FROM REGULAR BENEFITS.

IF AN INDIVIDUAL IS DISQUALIFIED FROM REGULAR BENEFITS FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF WEEKS UNDER § 8-1001, § 8-1003, OR § 8-1005 OF THIS TITLE, THE INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT RECEIVE EXTENDED BENEFITS UNLESS:

(1) THE PERIOD OF DISQUALIFICATION HAS ENDED; AND

(2) THE INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN EMPLOYED AFTER THE DATE OF THE DISQUALIFICATION.

(F) ACTIVE SEARCH FOR WORK.

(1) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL:

(I) MAKE A SUSTAINED AND SYSTEMATIC EFFORT THROUGHOUT THE WEEK TO FIND WORK; AND

(II) SUBMIT TANGIBLE EVIDENCE OF THE EFFORT TO THE SECRETARY.

(2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL IS DISQUALIFIED FOR EXTENDED BENEFITS FOR ANY WEEK OF UNEMPLOYMENT DURING THE INDIVIDUAL'S ELIGIBILITY PERIOD DURING WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL FAILS TO ACCEPT AN OFFER OF SUITABLE WORK OR APPLY FOR SUITABLE WORK REFERRED BY THE SECRETARY.

(3) IF AN INDIVIDUAL PROVIDES EVIDENCE THAT SATISFIES THE SECRETARY THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAS GOOD PROSPECTS FOR OBTAINING WORK IN THE INDIVIDUAL'S USUAL OCCUPATION WITHIN A REASONABLY SHORT PERIOD, SUITABILITY OF THE WORK SHALL BE DETERMINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 8-1005 RATHER THAN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(G) DUTY OF SECRETARY.

THE SECRETARY SHALL REFER AN INDIVIDUAL WHO APPLIES FOR EXTENDED BENEFITS TO WORK THAT IS SUITABLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the second sentence of former Art. 95A, § 11(a)(1) and § 21(a)(7) and (8), (c), (i), the first and third sentences of (j), and (k)(2), (3), and (4) and the first sentence of (1).

In subsection (b)(1)(i) of this section, the former reference to the "current benefit year which includes that week" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the use of the defined term "eligibility period".
