9-209. DOMESTIC SERVANT.

AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS EMPLOYED AS A DOMESTIC SERVANT IN A PRIVATE HOME IS A COVERED EMPLOYEE WITH RESPECT TO A HOUSEHOLD IF THE INDIVIDUAL EARNS AT LEAST \$250 IN CASH IN A CALENDAR QUARTER FROM THAT HOUSEHOLD.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 101, § 21(b)(9).

The word "individual" is substituted for the former word "person", since this title covers only a human being. As to the definition of "person", see § 1-101 of this article.

The phrase "with respect to a household" is added to clarify that an individual who is employed as a domestic servant in a private home is a covered employee only with respect to a household from which the individual earned at least \$250 in a calendar quarter.

The Labor and Employment Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that it is unclear whether the individual must earn at least \$250 in the calendar quarter in which the compensable event occurs or whether the individual may have earned at least \$250 in a prior calendar quarter. The General Assembly may wish to consider clarifying the calendar quarter that should be used to determine coverage.

9-210. FARM WORKER.

(A) DEFINITIONS.

(1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "FARMER" INCLUDES A DAIRY FARMER.

(3) (1) "MIGRANT FARM WORKER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ENGAGED IN SEASONAL OR OTHER TEMPORARY AGRICULTURAL EMPLOYMENT AND WHO IS:

1. ABSENT OVERNIGHT FROM THE PERMANENT RESIDENCE OF THE INDIVIDUAL; OR

2. TRANSPORTED TO AND FROM THE PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT OF THE INDIVIDUAL BY A DAY-HAUL OPERATION.
