

(B) EMPLOYER.

FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS TITLE, THE BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR ANY OTHER COUNTY IS THE EMPLOYER OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A COVERED EMPLOYEE UNDER THIS SECTION IN THAT COUNTY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language that repeats the provisions of current ED § 6-107(d)(2).

9-227. SOLE PROPRIETOR.

(A) IN GENERAL.

UNLESS AN ELECTION IS MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION, A SOLE PROPRIETOR IS NOT A COVERED EMPLOYEE.

(B) ELECTION.

A SOLE PROPRIETOR MAY ELECT TO BE A COVERED EMPLOYEE IF THE PROPRIETOR DEVOTES FULL TIME TO THE BUSINESS OF THE PROPRIETORSHIP.

(C) NOTICE OF ELECTION.

AN ELECTION UNDER THIS SECTION IS NOT EFFECTIVE UNTIL THE PROPRIETOR SUBMITS TO THE COMMISSION AND TO THE INSURER OF THE PROPRIETOR A WRITTEN NOTICE THAT NAMES THE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS TO BE A COVERED EMPLOYEE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 101, §§ 21(b)(3) and 67(4)(i), as they related to sole proprietorships.

Subsection (a) of this section is revised as an exclusion subject to an election, rather than an inclusion, for clarity. This revision also avoids the former dual reference to an "employer" or "sole proprietor", which are the same.

9-228. STUDENTS.

(A) HANDICAPPED STUDENT.

(1) A HANDICAPPED STUDENT IS A COVERED EMPLOYEE WHILE WORKING FOR AN EMPLOYER WITHOUT WAGES IN A WORK ASSIGNMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 8-401.1 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.
