- (2) KEEP, AT THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE COMMISSION, A PUBLIC RECORD OF:
  - (I) EACH PROCEEDING OF THE COMMISSION, INCLUDING:
    - 1. EACH CLAIM THAT THE COMMISSION CONSIDERS;

AND

- 2. EACH AWARD THAT THE COMMISSION ALLOWS TO AN EMPLOYEE OR ANY PERSON FOR A SERVICE;
- (II) EACH DOCUMENT REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED BY THE COMMISSION OR BY A REGULATION OF THE COMMISSION;
  - (III) EACH DECISION OF THE COMMISSION; AND
  - (IV) EACH ORDER PASSED BY THE COMMISSION.
  - (C) ABSENCE OF SECRETARY.

THE CHAIRMAN MAY DESIGNATE ANOTHER EMPLOYEE OF THE COMMISSION TO EXERCISE THE POWERS AND CARRY OUT THE DUTIES OF THE SECRETARY WHENEVER THE SECRETARY IS ABSENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the third sentence of former Art. 101, § 4, the first clause of the second sentence of § 6, and the first and third sentences of § 7.

In subsection (a) of this section, the power to "employ a staff for the Commission" is substituted for the former power "to make any future appointments", which referred to any appointment on or after June 1, 1939. See Ch. 732, Acts of 1939. The substituted language also clarifies that the staff is the staff of the "Commission". Accordingly, in subsection (c) of this section, the reference to "another employee of the Commission" is substituted for the former reference to "one of the clerks of the office, appointed by him".

In the introductory language of subsection (b)(2) of this section, the word "principal" is added to modify "office", since § 9-306 of this subtitle authorizes more than 1 office.

Also in the introductory language of subsection (b)(2) of this section, the words "full and true", which formerly modified "record", are deleted as implicit. Similarly, the former duties to "maintain" the record and to be responsible for "the safe custody and preservation of ... documents" are deleted as implicit in the word "keep".

In subsection (b)(2)(ii) of this section, the former word "papers" is deleted in light of the word "document".
