In subsection (b)(2)(iii) of this section, the former reference to "decisions or orders made by any member of the Commission" is deleted as unnecessary since, under § 9-308(b) of this subtitle, a decision or order of a member is a decision or order of the Commission.

Also in subsection (b)(2)(iii) of this section, the former reference to a decision or order "approved and confirmed by it [the Commission] and ordered filed" is deleted as unnecessary, since approval or confirmation makes a decision or order that of the Commission.

In subsection (c) of this section, the former phrase "from time to time" is deleted as surplusage.

The first sentence of former Art. 101, § 6, which provided that "present" employees of the Commission retain their rights under Art. 64A of the Code, is deleted as obsolete, since the former sentence referred to employees in 1939. See Ch. 732, Acts of 1939.

The second clause of the second sentence of former Art. 101, § 6, which required appointments to be made "in accordance with the provisions of said Article 64A", is deleted as surplusage, since the Merit System Law would apply in any event.

The third and fourth sentences of former Art. 101, § 6, which allowed employees "actual necessary expenses while traveling" as allowed by the Chairman, are deleted since employees of the Commission, as State employees, are subject to the Standard State Travel Regulations. See SF § 10–203 and COMAR 23.02.01.01 through .12.

9-306. OFFICES.

THE COMMISSION:

- (1) SHALL HAVE ITS PRINCIPAL OFFICE IN BALTIMORE CITY;
- (2) MAY HAVE IN THE STATE ANY BRANCH OFFICES THAT THE CHAIRMAN CONSIDERS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS TITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 101, § 1(g) and the fifth sentence of § 6.

The former duties to "maintain" the offices and to provide "suitable rooms, necessary office furniture, supplies, books, periodicals and maps" are deleted as unnecessary in light of § 9–303(b)(1) of this subtitle.
