

THE COMMISSION SHALL COMPUTE ALL COMPENSATION AWARDED UNDER THIS TITLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPLICABLE SCHEDULE IN THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) ROUNDING OFF.

IN COMPUTING THE RATE OF COMPENSATION, THE COMMISSION SHALL ROUND OFF ANY FRACTIONAL DOLLAR OF COMPENSATION TO THE NEXT HIGHER DOLLAR.

9-605. PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION BY EMPLOYER OR INSURER.

IF AN EMPLOYER OR ITS INSURER WHOLLY OR PARTLY PAYS COMPENSATION, THE PAYMENT BARS RECOVERY FROM THE OTHER OF THE AMOUNT PAID.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the second clause of former Art. 101, § 19(a).

The former phrase "to the extent thereof" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the phrase "of the amount paid", which makes it clear that payment is a bar only to the extent of the amount paid.

9-606. ILLEGALLY EMPLOYED MINOR — DOUBLE COMPENSATION.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN A CLAIM INVOLVING A MINOR WHO IS EMPLOYED ILLEGALLY UNDER STATE LAW, THE COMMISSION MAY DOUBLE THE AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION AND DEATH BENEFITS AUTHORIZED BY THIS TITLE.

(B) LIABILITY FOR EXCESS AWARD.

WHEN THE COMMISSION AWARDS DOUBLE COMPENSATION OR DEATH BENEFITS UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION:

(1) THE EMPLOYER OF THE MINOR IS SOLELY LIABLE FOR THE INCREASED AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION OR DEATH BENEFITS; AND

(2) AN INSURANCE POLICY MAY NOT PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT OR INDEMNIFICATION OF THE EMPLOYER OF THE MINOR FOR PAYMENT OF THE INCREASED AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION OR DEATH BENEFITS.
