FOR PURPOSES OF THIS TITLE, A CERTIFICATE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY IS CONCLUSIVE EVIDENCE OF THE LEGALITY OF ANY EMPLOYMENT OF A MINOR.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the second sentence of former Art. 101, § 47.

In subsection (b)(2) of this section, the words "provide for payment or indemnification", are substituted for the former words "be available to protect", for clarity and to conform with the terminology used in Subtitle 4 of this title.

In subsection (c) of this section, the phrase "of a minor" is added to state expressly that which only was implied in the former law — <u>i.e.</u>, the presumption applies to minors.

9-607. PRISONER.

(A) WAITING PERIOD.

THE COMMISSION MAY NOT AWARD COMPENSATION TO A PRISONER WHO IS A COVERED EMPLOYEE UNDER § 9–221 OF THIS TITLE UNTIL THE PRISONER IS DISCHARGED BY PARDON, PAROLE, OR EXPIRATION OF SENTENCE.

(B) DEATH BENEFITS.

IF A PRISONER DIES FROM AN ACCIDENTAL INJURY, THE DEPENDENTS OF THE PRISONER ARE ENTITLED TO COMPENSATION UNDER THIS TITLE, BASED ON THE AVERAGE WEEKLY WAGE OF THE PRISONER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 101, § 35(c) and the second sentence of (b), as it related to providing that the Commission may not award compensation to a prisoner until the prisoner is discharged.

In subsection (b) of this section, the phrases "arising out of and in the course of his employment within the meaning of this article", which formerly modified "accidental injury", are deleted in light of the definition of "accidental injury". As to the definition of "accidental injury", see § 9–101 of this title.
