- (1) A FIRE FIGHTER, FIRE FIGHTING INSTRUCTOR, OR PARAMEDIC EMPLOYED BY:
 - (I) A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION;
 - (II) A COUNTY;
 - (III) THE STATE;
 - (IV) THE STATE AIRPORT AUTHORITY; OR
 - (V) A FIRE CONTROL DISTRICT: OR
- (2) A VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTER OR VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE, RESCUE, OR ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT WORKER WHO IS A COVERED EMPLOYEE UNDER § 9–234 OF THIS TITLE AND WHO PROVIDES VOLUNTEER FIRE OR RESCUE SERVICES TO:
 - (I) A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION;
 - (II) A COUNTY;
 - (III) THE STATE;
 - (IV) THE STATE AIRPORT AUTHORITY; OR
 - (V) A FIRE CONTROL DISTRICT; OR
 - (3) A POLICE OFFICER EMPLOYED BY:
 - (I) A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION:
 - (II) A COUNTY;
 - (III) THE STATE;
 - (IV) THE STATE AIRPORT AUTHORITY; OR
- (V) THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION.
 - (B) ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1988.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION, IF A COVERED EMPLOYEE IS AWARDED COMPENSATION FOR LESS THAN 75 WEEKS IN A CLAIM ARISING FROM EVENTS OCCURRING ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1988, THE EMPLOYER OR ITS INSURER SHALL PAY THE COVERED EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION THAT EQUALS ONE-THIRD OF THE AVERAGE WEEKLY WAGE OF THE COVERED EMPLOYEE BUT DOES NOT EXCEED \$80.
