

(III) AGREES TO REIMBURSE THE FUND FOR PAYMENT OF AN AWARD OR TO PAY THE ASSESSMENT DUE TO THE FUND IN A MANNER APPROVED BY THE BOARD.

In subsections (a) and (c) of this section, the reference to a "permit" is added to conform to subsection (a)(2) of this section and to reflect the use of the term "permit" throughout the revised articles of the Code to denote the authorization of a corporation or partnership to operate a business through which the practice of a particular occupation is conducted.

In subsections (a)(2), (b)(1), and (c)(1) of this section, the word "unit" is substituted for the former term "agency" to conform to terminology used throughout the revised article of the Code.

9-1013. COMPROMISE OF JUDGMENT.

(A) AUTHORIZED.

(1) IF THE DIRECTOR CONSIDERS COMPROMISE TO BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE FUND, THE DIRECTOR MAY COMPROMISE THE AMOUNT OF A JUDGMENT AGAINST AN EMPLOYER UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(2) A COMPROMISE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE APPROVED BY ANY OTHER STATE OFFICIAL TO BE EFFECTIVE.

(B) LIMIT.

A COMPROMISE UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF BENEFITS PAYABLE TO OR FOR A COVERED EMPLOYEE OR THE DEPENDENTS OF A COVERED EMPLOYEE.

(C) MODIFICATION OF JUDGMENT.

A JUDGMENT MAY BE MODIFIED TO REFLECT A COMPROMISE UNDER THIS SECTION.
