SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments

297B.

 or credit in a financial institution as defined in § 1-101(h) of the Financial Institutions
