

- (i) Take corrective action within a time set in the order;
 - (ii) File with the WSSC a written report about the alleged violation;
 - (iii) Appear at a hearing before the WSSC at a time and place the WSSC sets to answer the charges in the order; or
 - (iv) File a written report and also appear at a hearing before the WSSC at a time and place the WSSC sets to answer the charges in the order.
- (2) Any order issued under this subsection is effective immediately when it is served.

Error: Title of bill being cured incorrectly stated that the bill required the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to issue certain administrative orders for certain violations of the WSSC Pretreatment Program.

Article 41 – Governor – Executive and Administrative Departments

13-105.

The Authority shall have perpetual existence and may:

- (1) Adopt a seal and alter the same at its pleasure;
- (2) Acquire, hold and dispose of real and personal property for its corporate purposes;

Article 88B – State Police

9.

(a) The Department shall collect, analyze, and disseminate information relative to the incidence of crime within the State.

(b) (1) The Department shall collect and analyze information relating to incidents apparently directed against an individual or group because of the individual's or the group's race, religion, ethnicity, or sexual orientation.

(2) Each local law enforcement agency and the State Fire Marshal shall provide the Department the information described in paragraph (1) of this subsection.
