(e) A permit is not required for the testing of trucks serviced or repaired by a garage licensed under [Article 56, § 160 of the Code] TITLE 17, SUBTITLE 8 OF THE BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE if:

(1) All laws of the Transportation Article are observed by a garage owner in regard to size, weight, and speed restrictions of the particular type of truck tested; and

(2) All local motor vehicle traffic, speed, and safety ordinances are complied with.

26-201.

(a) A police officer may charge a person with a violation of any of the following, if the officer has probable cause to believe that the person has committed or is committing the violation:

(5) [Article 56, § 148 of the Code] TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 4 OF THE BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

190A.

In a prosecution for selling alcoholic beverages without an appropriate license, proof that the defendant displayed or offered [the] alcoholic beverages for sale or kept a place of business where [the] alcoholic beverages were displayed or offered for sale is prima facie evidence that the defendant sold [the] alcoholic beverages.
