

(3) WITH A SURETY THAT THE COMMISSION APPROVES; AND

(4) CONDITIONED ON THE PAYMENT, WITHIN THE TIME THAT THE COMMISSION SETS, OF ALL EXPENSES INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONTEST.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 113.

The Business Regulation Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that this section is revised to make it applicable to kick boxing contests as well as boxing or wrestling contests.

4-307. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE.

THE COMMISSION SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO EACH APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the references, in the introductory language of former Art. 56, § 112AB(a) and (b), to the power of the Commission to issue licenses for professional kick boxing, boxing and sparring, or wrestling matches and exhibitions.

The word "shall" is substituted for the former word "may" to reflect the implied duty of the Commission to issue a license to a qualified applicant.

4-308. SCOPE OF LICENSE.

(A) BOXER LICENSE.

A BOXER LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PARTICIPATE AS A BOXER IN A CONTEST.

(B) KICK BOXER LICENSE.

A KICK BOXER LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PARTICIPATE AS A KICK BOXER IN A CONTEST.

(C) WRESTLER LICENSE.

A WRESTLER LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PARTICIPATE AS A WRESTLER IN A CONTEST.

(D) MANAGER LICENSE.
