ANY CLERK WHO SHALL REFUSE OR NEGLECT TO RETURN TO THE COMPTROLLER LISTS AND ACCOUNTS OF ALL LICENSES ISSUED BY HIM, AS HEREINBEFORE REQUIRED, SHALL BE CHARGED BY THE COMPTROLLER WITH THE WHOLE AMOUNT OF BLANK LICENSES DELIVERED TO HIM, AT THE SEVERAL RATES FIXED BY LAW THEREFOR; AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL IMMEDIATELY THEREAFTER DIRECT THE OFFICIAL BOND OF SUCH CLERK TO BE PUT IN SUIT FOR THE RECOVERY THEREOF.

SECTIONS 66 THROUGH 69 OF THIS ARTICLE APPLY TO ALL LICENSES ISSUED BY THE CLERKS OF THE COURTS OTHER THAN THOSE ISSUED UNDER TITLE 17 OF THE BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE.

HE SHALL CAUSE TO BE PRINTED OR OTHERWISE PREPARED, IN THE FORMS PRESCRIBED BY LAW OR USAGE, BLANK LICENSES OF EVERY KIND AND DESCRIPTION ISSUED BY THE CLERKS OF THE COURTS OF THIS STATE, AND AUTHORIZED BY LAW AND SHALL DELIVER TO THE SAID CLERKS THE NUMBER AND DESCRIPTION OF LICENSES REQUIRED BY THEM.

SECTION 23 OF THIS ARTICLE APPLIES TO ALL LICENSES ISSUED BY THE CLERKS OF THE COURTS OTHER THAN THOSE ISSUED UNDER TITLE 17 OF THE BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE.

SECTION 4. 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of Section 3 of this Act are intended solely to correct technical errors in the current law and to conform to terminology in the Business Regulation Article (as enacted by Chapter ____ (S.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1992) and there is no intent for Section 3 of this Act to revive or otherwise affect law that is the subject of other Acts, whether those Acts were signed by the Governor before or after the signing of this Act.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of Section 5 of this Act are intended to enact provisions that were inadvertently repealed in the Business Regulation Article (as enacted by Chapter ____ (S.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1992) and to provide for the applicability of these provisions.

SECTION 5. 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the approval of the Revisor of Statutes, the publishers of the Annotated Code of Maryland shall propose the correction of cross-references that are rendered incorrect by this Act or by Chapter ____ (S.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1992.
