~~SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 28

(House Bill 124)

AN ACT concerning

Cosmetology — Supervision of Apprentices Barbers and Cosmetologists

FOR the purpose of authorizing certain holders of certain limited cosmetology licenses with certain experience to supervise certain apprentices under certain circumstances; ~~providing for the qualifications of licensed senior estheticians and manicurists;~~ authorizing certain apprentice barbers and cosmetologists to learn to practice their trade in either a barbershop or a beauty salon under certain circumstances; requiring the State Boards of Barbers and Cosmetologists to issue a barbershop permit and a beauty salon permit for a single location under certain circumstances; altering certain provisions relating to the staff of the Board; altering a certain definition; defining certain terms; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the supervision of apprentices by holders of certain senior practice licenses regulation of barbers and cosmetologists.
