

(6) One representative of the Maryland Frozen Food Locker Association, Inc.; and

(7) Four representatives of the slaughtering and processing industry, two appointed from the State at large and two from Baltimore City.

The Secretary shall designate the eleventh member who shall be an ex officio member possessing all the rights and privileges of the other Council members, except the right to vote.

(d) The members of the Council shall select the Chairman from among the members. The chairman shall call meetings of the Council. The Council shall also appoint a secretary and other clerks, with the salaries provided in the annual State budget. The members of the Council shall receive no salary as members, but shall be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred in attending meetings and other business of the Council.

(e) The Council shall submit its recommendations in writing to the Secretary through its executive officer. The executive officer shall notify the Council of the Secretary's action on the recommendations.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
