CHAPTER 39

(House Bill 204)

AN ACT concerning

Department of Juvenile Services – State Advisory Board – Frequency of Meetings

FOR the purpose of altering the minimum number of times the Department of Juvenile Services State Advisory Board must meet each year.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 83C – Juvenile Services

Section 2-109

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1991 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 83C – Juvenile Services

2-109.

(a) The State Advisory Board shall meet regularly at least [10] 6 times a year, on the call of its chairman.

(b) A member of the State Advisory Board:

(1) May not receive compensation; but

(2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

(c) A member of the State Advisory Board may not have a direct or indirect interest in any contract for building, repairing, equipping, or providing materials or supplies to the Department or have any other financial interest in a contract with the Department.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1992.
