

(b) Before it registers any organization or agency, the Division of [Vocational] Rehabilitation SERVICES shall inspect the sheltered workshop facilities to determine if:

- (1) They are appropriate;
- (2) The agency or organization is eligible to receive funds under this subtitle; and

(3) The facilities meet the standards for sheltered workshops accepted by the Rehabilitation Services Administration of the federal Department of Education.

The Division of [Vocational] Rehabilitation SERVICES may contract with any approved agency or organization to provide programs and services set forth in § 21-302.1(d) of this title to any disabled individual if the Division is satisfied that [he] THE INDIVIDUAL:

- (1) Is at least 17 years old;
- (2) Cannot find employment in the open labor market; and
- (3) May be expected to benefit from the programs and services set forth in § 21-302.1(d) of this title or that [his] THE INDIVIDUAL'S best interests [requires] REQUIRE this type of employment.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 43

(House Bill 253)

AN ACT concerning

Secretary of Agriculture – Testing Program for Weights and Measures

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Agriculture to establish a voluntary weights and measures testing program; authorizing the Secretary to issue, deny, or revoke a certain certificate of approval under certain circumstances; creating a certain prohibition; establishing a certain special fund for the weights and measures testing program; establishing certain fees; and generally relating to the weights and measures testing program.
