Section 2

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

15-201.

(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

(B) “APPLICANT” MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO APPLIES FOR ASSISTANCE FROM THE PROGRAM.

[(b)](C) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, “family” means:

(i) The applicant OR RECIPIENT;

(ii) The applicant’s OR RECIPIENT’S spouse if the spouse lives with the applicant OR RECIPIENT; and

(iii) The applicant’s OR RECIPIENT’S children under the age of [21] 18 years if the children live with the applicant OR RECIPIENT.

(2) If the applicant is a child under the age of [21] 18 years, “family” means:

(i) The minor applicant’s OR RECIPIENT’S parents; and

(ii) At the option of the minor applicant’s OR RECIPIENT’S parents, the minor applicant’s OR RECIPIENT’S siblings.

[(c)](D) “Program” means the Maryland AIDS Insurance Assistance [Pilot] Program.

[(d)](E) “Recipient” means an individual receiving assistance from the Program.

(a) The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall administer a Maryland AIDS Insurance Assistance [Pilot] Program for HIV positive individuals.
