

(n) The Commissioner, or the Commissioner's designee, may remove an inmate from the program at any time and for any reason.

(o) (1) With the approval of the Secretary, the Commissioner shall adopt reasonable regulations to implement the program.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of § 10-101(e)(2)(i) of the State Government Article the regulations shall be adopted under Title 10, Subtitle 1 of the State Government Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 48

(House Bill 269)

AN ACT concerning

Trade and Service Marks – Fees

FOR the purpose of altering the fees charged for registering, assigning, and renewing a trade or service mark.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Business Regulation

Section 1-406(a), 1-410(c), and 1-411(c)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(As enacted by Chapter ____ (S.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1992)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Business Regulation

1-406.

(a) An applicant for registration of a mark shall:

(1) submit to the Secretary of State:

(i) an application on the form that the Secretary of State provides;

and

(ii) 3 specimens or reproductions of the mark; and

(2) pay to the Secretary of State a fee of ~~[\$10]~~ ~~\$20~~ \$50.
