

(2) EXPENSES FOR ADMINISTRATIVE, LEGAL, ACTUARIAL, TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE, AND OTHER SERVICES.

(C) IN MAKING SPECIAL LOANS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, CONSIDERATION SHALL BE GIVEN TO:

(1) COMMUNITY NEED;

(2) COMMUNITY INCOME, WITH PRIORITY GIVEN TO THOSE COMMUNITIES WITH THE LOWEST MEDIAN FAMILY INCOME;

(3) CARE FOR CHILDREN WITH TEENAGE PARENTS IN SCHOOL OR TRAINING;

(4) CARE FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS; AND

(5) INFANT CARE.

EACH YEAR, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT AS TO:

(1) THE STATUS OF THE MONEY INVESTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE;

(2) THE MARKET VALUE OF THE ASSETS IN THE FUND AS OF THE DATE OF THE REPORT; AND

(3) THE INTEREST RECEIVED FROM INVESTMENTS FOR THE FUND DURING THE PERIOD COVERED BY THE REPORT.

SUBJECT TO THE RESTRICTIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE DEPARTMENT, ON APPLICATION, MAY PROVIDE A LOAN TO THE APPLICANT FROM THE FUND.

6-3A-07.

THE DEPARTMENT MAY MAKE A LOAN TO AN APPLICANT ONLY IF:

(1) THE APPLICANT MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED BY THIS SUBTITLE;

(2) THE APPLICANT MEETS ANY ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED BY THE SOURCE OF THE FUNDS TO BE LOANED; AND

(3) THE LOAN WILL BE USED TO ASSIST APPLICANTS IN MEETING APPLICABLE STATE AND LOCAL CHILD CARE STANDARDS.
