[(c) If a person secures the proper permit, the person, whether or not licensed, may perform any plumbing work on any residential or commercial property owned by the person.]

CHAPTER 53

(House Bill 451)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Electrical Work - Repeal of License Exemption

FOR the purpose of repealing a certain license exemption that authorizes an owner of a residential or commercial building in Frederick County to perform electrical work on the building without a certain license as long as the owner obtains an electrical permit and signs a certain statement.

Article 11 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

(1979 Edition and May, 1991 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 11 - Frederick County

1-7-102.

(a) The provisions of this division shall not apply to:

[(4) The owner of a residential or commercial building who obtains an electrical permit and who signs a statement as shown in Exhibit A on file in the office of the board of county commissioners.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
