

(2) A license for an accredited hospital expires when the certificate of accreditation expires.

(3) A LICENSE FOR A NURSING FACILITY SHALL BE FOR A 2-YEAR TERM.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
