

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

8.

(b-1) In Dorchester County the annual license fee [for such license shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00)] IS \$200.

9.

(b-1) In Dorchester County the annual license fee [for such license shall be one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00)] IS \$250.

10.

(g-1) In Dorchester County the annual fee [for such license shall be one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00)] IS \$250.

11.

(g-1) In Dorchester County the annual fee [for such license shall be one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00)] IS \$250.

14.

(k) (1) In Dorchester County, a Class B (on-sale and off-sale) beer and light wine license shall be issued:

(i) Only to restaurants; and

(ii) Without seating capacity restrictions.

(2) The annual fee for this license is [\$200] \$300.

(3) The holder of a license shall purchase all of the wine sold under this license from Dorchester County Liquor Control Board dispensaries.

19.

(k) (1) In Dorchester County, bona fide restaurants, motels and hotels having restaurant facilities for serving full-course meals at least twice daily and seating capacity at tables for 100 or more persons, not including seats at bars or counters, upon payment of an annual license fee of [\$250] \$500 may obtain a license from the County Commissioners and this license entitles the licensee to sell beer, wines and liquors. All restaurants, motels and hotels shall purchase all wines and liquors sold by them from the Dorchester County Liquor Control Board dispensaries.

(2) This license provides for the consumption of wine and liquor on the premises only.

(g) In Dorchester County the annual fee [for such a license shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00)] IS \$500. Such a license may be obtained by (1) any bona fide yacht club and golf and country club operating in Dorchester County, having been incorporated
