

SALE OF BEER OR OTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, NOR FROM ANY AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF SUCH PERSON OR CORPORATION, OR FROM ANY LICENSEE, LICENSED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE. NO PERSON OR CORPORATION ENGAGED IN THE MANUFACTURE OR SALE OF BEER OR OTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, NOR ANY AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF SUCH PERSON OR CORPORATION, AND NO LICENSEE LICENSED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, SHALL, EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, OFFER TO PAY ANY COMMISSION, PROFIT OR REMUNERATION OR MAKE ANY GIFT TO ANY COMMISSIONER TO ANYONE ON BEHALF OF SUCH COMMISSIONERS.

(III) A LICENSE COMMISSIONER VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THIS APPOINTED OFFICE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the members of the Charles County License Commissioners in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act shall take effect at the beginning of a commissioner's term or next term of office. On June 30, 1994 this Act shall apply to all of the commissioners in office or appointed to the Charles County License Commissioners on or after that date.

SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 59

(House Bill 1389)

AN ACT concerning

Unemployment Insurance – Unpaid Contributions and Reimbursements – Interest

FOR the purpose of altering the rate of interest charged by the Secretary of the Department of Economic and Employment Development that accrues for a contribution or reimbursement payment that is due and unpaid; making this Act an emergency measure; and providing for the termination of this Act.
