SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Labor and Employment

8-628.

A contribution or reimbursement payment that is due and unpaid shall accrue interest at the rate of [1.5%] 1% per month or part of a month from the date on which it is due until the Secretary receives the contribution or payment in lieu of contributions and the interest.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all of the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective until October 1, 1994 and, at the end of September 30, 1994, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and no further force and effect.

CHAPTER 60

(Senate Bill 155)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Stadium Authority – Development and Convention Powers

FOR the purpose of permitting the Maryland Stadium Authority, subject to the approval of the Board of Public Works and the Legislative Policy Committee, to engage in public or private development of certain portions of Camden Yards; providing that except for condemnation power, the Authority may exercise certain of its powers with respect to development projects; providing for the Maryland Stadium Authority to assume certain powers relating to convention center facilities; providing that at least 1 member of the Maryland Stadium Authority be a resident shall be nominated by the Mayor of Baltimore City; establishing a separate Baltimore Convention Center Financing Fund; providing for the transition of certain transactions, functions, records, and appropriations; abolishing the Baltimore Convention Center Authority; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to development powers of the Maryland Stadium Authority.
