~~(5) (I) UPON EMPLOYMENT IN A VETERANS' PROGRAM, A VETERAN SHALL REGISTER WITH THE BOARD ON A FORM SUPPLIED BY THE BOARD.~~

~~(II) THE REGISTRATION FORM SHALL INCLUDE THE EXPECTED DATE OF GRADUATION OF THE VETERAN FROM THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM WHICH HAS ACCEPTED THE VETERAN.~~

~~(III) THE BOARD MAY SET REASONABLE FEES FOR REGISTERING VETERANS EMPLOYED IN VETERANS' PROGRAMS.~~

~~(IV) THE FEE CHARGED SHALL BE SET SO AS TO PRODUCE FUNDS TO APPROXIMATE THE COST OF REGISTERING VETERANS ENROLLED IN VETERANS' PROGRAMS.~~

~~(6) A VETERAN EMPLOYED IN A VETERANS' PROGRAM MAY PRACTICE RESPIRATORY CARE, UNDER ON SITE SUPERVISION BY A CERTIFIED RESPIRATORY CARE PRACTITIONER OR A PHYSICIAN OF THE VETERANS' PROGRAM, ONLY IN THE COURSE OF EMPLOYMENT BY THE VETERANS' PROGRAM.~~

~~(I) THE VETERAN FAILS TO ENROLL IN AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM WITHIN A REASONABLE PERIOD OF TIME AFTER EMPLOYMENT BY A VETERANS' PROGRAM;~~

~~(II) THE VETERAN FAILS REASONABLY TO MAINTAIN ENROLLMENT AND GOOD STANDING IN AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM; OR~~

(3) A VETERANS' PROGRAM MAY ACCEPT A VETERAN WHO:

(I) APPLIES TO THE BOARD WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF DISCHARGE, PROVIDES THE BOARD THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, AND IS APPROVED BY THE BOARD;
