(2) ~~The governing body of each county and Baltimore City shall notify the Governor within twenty days of the date on which this bill becomes law of specific appropriations of State aid to that county or Baltimore City which are to be reduced.~~

(3) ~~Notwithstanding any other provision of law, pursuant to subsection (a)(2) of this section, the county or Baltimore City may designate any appropriation of State aid including State aid for local employees' fringe benefits for social security contributions as provided under §§ 5-202(d) and 23-403(e) of the Education Article, for retirement benefits as provided under Article 73B, §§ 89(4), 102, 110, 150(4) and 162 and for education as provided in § 5-202 of the Education Article. Any reductions made pursuant to this subsection shall be subject to the provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of Chapter 3 of the Acts of the General Assembly of the Second Special Session of 1991.~~

(4) ~~Notwithstanding the provisions of § 2-608 of the Tax General Article, the Comptroller shall withhold from the county or Baltimore City an amount of the income tax from individuals attributable to the county or Baltimore City income tax equal to the amount specified in subsection (a)(1) of this section for which the county or Baltimore City has not provided notification to the Governor as provided in subsection (a)(2).~~

(b) ~~The amount of any reduction in appropriations made under this section shall be credited to the General Fund of the State.~~

(c) ~~The amounts withheld by the Comptroller under subsection (a)(4) of this section shall be credited to the General Fund of the State.~~
