

programs. The Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations for the implementation and application of the formula outlined herein. Furthermore, the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene may determine priorities which should be addressed by each county in their plans and budgets for all health services. These priorities are to reduce infant mortality; prevent avoidable illness, disability and deaths; reduce teen pregnancy; reduce maternal mortality; protect the public's health through food sanitation, environmental inspections, proper water and sewer systems, pest control and safe recreational facilities; reduce the communicability of disease; provide needed community health services; investigate and control outbreaks of disease; and increase the public's awareness to health and illness prevention.
