

(b) Transfer of funds from the Mental Hygiene Administration institutions to Mental Hygiene Administration community services is allowed.

(2) Funds appropriated in any of the Mental Hygiene Administration institutions may be transferred among Mental Hygiene institutions.

(3) Nothing in this section shall prevent the transfer of funds from the programs in the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to Mental Hygiene Administration institutions.
