change, and the committees shall have 45 days to review and consider it before it becomes effective.

Further, \$1,000,000 of the General Fund
Appropriation may be used for a grant to
Baltimore Medical Systems, Inc., provided
the budget committees have 45 days to
review any such grant.

Further, \$1,427,683 of the General Fund
Appropriation shall be reduced upon
enactment of legislation HB 194 authorizing
the Maryland Pharmacy Assistance Program
and the Maryland Medical Assistance
Program to limit coverage of
pharmaceutical products to manufacturers
who agree to provide rebates to the state on
the same basis as is required for the Title
XIX Medicaid Program under the Omnibus
Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990.

Further, \$2,500,000 of the General Fund Appropriation and \$2,045,454 of the Federal Fund Appropriation shall be reduced contingent upon enactment of legislation (HB 280) establishing the Motorcycle Catastrophic/Rehabilitation Health Insurance Policy as a required form of security for owners of motorcycles registered in Maryland.

Further, \$3,000,000 \$4,600,000 of the General
Fund Appropriation and \$2,997,000
\$4,595,400 of the Federal Fund
Appropriation shall be reduced contingent
upon enactment of legislation (HB 1505)
prohibiting alimony awards made for the
purpose of obtaining Medical Assistance
eligibility, assessing penalties against
spouses of Medical Assistance recipients
refusing to pay for nursing home care, and
altering the days or payments to nursing
facilities for reserved beds.

Further, \$2,000,000 of the General Fund
Appropriation and \$1,689,600 of the
Federal Fund Appropriation shall be
