

and General Public Assistance Program (GPA) may only be expended for program restructuring. Further, \$1.5 million of the GPA appropriation may only be expended for expansion of the Disability Entitlement Advocacy Program (DEAP). Any funds remaining for DEAP program expansion shall revert to the general fund at the end of the fiscal year.

It is the intent of the Committees that the Department of Human Resources modify regulations to address loan provisions for recipients with disabilities of three months or less under the current GPA program or any successor program.
