The State Department of Education, in conjunction with the Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning, shall study the functions of LEA's and the SDOE with respect to the duties and responsibilities assigned by law and regulation and the proper placement of responsibility for each function or supervisory function so identified. The report shall recommend action to eliminate duplication and, where necessary, assign administrative and supervisory responsibility for each function and recommend actions which can be taken to increase efficiency and economy in the state and local administration of elementary-secondary education. This report shall be submitted to the budget committees by October 1, 1992.

The State Department of Education, in conjunction with the Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning and the Maryland Association of Boards of Education shall study the functions of the SDOE with respect to the duties and responsibilities assigned by law and regulation (including duties and responsibilities vis-a-vis the local education agencies) and the proper placement of responsibility for each function so identified. The study shall be limited to current state and federal requirements for elementary-secondary education under law and regulation. Among other recommendations that the participants may wish to include, the study shall recommend any necessary actions to eliminate duplication and, where necessary, reassign administrative and supervisory responsibilities, and other actions which can be taken to increase efficiency and economy. This report shall be submitted to the budget committees by October 1, 1992.
