

(1) Funds may be expended only for the capital programs and projects identified in Section 1 except as expressly authorized by statute and may not be transferred to any other programs or projects. In programs for which multiple projects are listed, including 30.01.02.02 and 39.01.01.03, the restriction is applicable to the amount listed for each project included as part of the total appropriation.

(2) Expenditures from these appropriations are capital expenditures governed by Section 7-305 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

(b) Funds appropriated in the Office of the Secretary of the Department of Human Resources for the Homeless Service Program may be transferred to the Shelter and Nutrition Program 33.03.01.05 for use in two capital projects.

(c) Funds appropriated to the revolving loan account of the Division of Housing Finance of the Department of Housing and Community Development may be transferred among those accounts to the extent and in such manner as is expressly authorized by law for those programs, provided that aggregate expenditures may not exceed the amount stated in Section 1 for those programs.

(d) Funds appropriated to the capital accounts of the Department of Economic and Employment Development may be transferred among those accounts to the extent and in such a manner as is expressly authorized by law for those programs, provided that aggregate expenditures may not exceed the amount stated in Section 1 for those programs.

SECTION 24. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the fiscal year 1993 appropriations made in Section 1 to the programs listed below shall be reduced by the amounts indicated for the purpose of reducing out of state conference travel:
