

It is the intent of the General Assembly that these reductions may be allocated among the programs in each agency. Further provided that funds remaining for this purpose may be allocated at the discretion of the agency for out of state conference travel, association dues, or subscriptions.

SECTION 26. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the fiscal year 1993 appropriations made in Section 1 to the programs listed below shall be reduced by the amounts indicated for the purpose of reducing association dues:
