It is the intent of the General Assembly that these reductions may be allocated among the programs in each agency.

SECTION 30. 29. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That no funds may be expended for the purchase, lease or operation of car and portable phones except consistent with a policy promulgated by the Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning in consultation with the Department of General Services. This policy shall establish:

- (1) criteria for determining which positions, functions or operations are cost effectively served by car phones;
- (2) guidelines for appropriate business use of car phones and recovery of costs resulting from personal use of them;
- (3) procedures for assuring that criteria and guidelines are appropriately applied across state government.

The Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning shall submit this policy and an implementation plan to the budget committees of the General Assembly for their review not later than June 1, 1992.

This section shall not apply to car and portable phones for use by statewide elected officials, the presiding offices of the legislature, the chief judge of the Court of Appeals, the Chief Administrative Judge of the District Court, cabinet secretaries and deputy secretaries, agency heads, the chancellor of the University of Maryland System, and the presidents of public institutions of higher éducation.

SECTION 31. 30. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning in consultation with the Department of General Services shall adopt guidelines to govern use of funds herein appropriated for printing by or on behalf of state agencies. This policy should restrict use of multicolored printing, glossy stock and similar high cost processes exclusively to documents necessary to promote economic development and similar, essential statewide objectives.
