(E) IN DETERMINING WHETHER TO ORDER THE RESPONDENT TO VACATE THE FAMILY HOME UNDER § 4-505(A)(2)(IV) OF THIS SUBTITLE OR SUBSECTION (D)(4) OF THIS SECTION, THE COURT SHALL CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING FACTORS:

(1) THE HOUSING NEEDS OF ANY MINOR CHILDREN CHILD LIVING IN THE FAMILY HOME;

(2) THE DURATION OF THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE RESPONDENT AND ANY PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF;

(3) TITLE TO THE FAMILY HOME;

(4) PENDENCY AND TYPE OF CRIMINAL CHARGES AGAINST THE RESPONDENT;

(5) THE HISTORY AND SEVERITY OF ABUSE IN THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE RESPONDENT AND ANY PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF;

(6) THE EXISTENCE OF ALTERNATIVE HOUSING FOR EITHER PARTY THE RESPONDENT AND ANY PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF; AND

(7) THE FINANCIAL RESOURCES OF THE PARTIES RESPONDENT AND THE PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF.
