- (8) AWARD TEMPORARY MONETARY RELIEF EMERGENCY FAMILY MAINTENANCE AS NECESSARY TO SUPPORT THE PETITIONER OR ANY CHILD IN THE PETITIONER'S CARE OR CUSTODY, OR BOTH, ANY PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF TO WHOM THE RESPONDENT HAS A DUTY OF SUPPORT UNDER TITLE 1, TITLE 5, TITLE 8, TITLE 10, TITLE 11, OR TITLE 12 OF THIS ARTICLE:
- (9) AWARD TEMPORARY USE AND POSSESSION OF A JOINTLY OWNED VEHICLE JOINTLY OWNED BY THE RESPONDENT AND A PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF TO THE PETITIONER PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF IF NECESSARY FOR THE PETITIONER'S EMPLOYMENT OF THE PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF OR FOR THE CARE OF A MINOR CHILD OF THE RESPONDENT OR A PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF;
- (10) DIRECT <u>THE RESPONDENT OR</u> ANY OR ALL OF THE <u>PARTIES</u> <u>PERSONS ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF</u> TO PARTICIPATE IN A PROFESSIONALLY SUPERVISED COUNSELING OR A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM; <u>AND OR</u>
- (11) ORDER THE RESPONDENT TO PAY FILING FEES AND COSTS OF A PROCEEDING UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- (12) ORDER ANY OTHER RELIEF AS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (E) IN DETERMINING WHETHER TO ORDER THE RESPONDENT TO VACATE THE FAMILY HOME UNDER § 4–505(A)(2)(IV) OF THIS SUBTITLE OR SUBSECTION (D)(4) OF THIS SECTION, THE COURT SHALL CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING FACTORS:
- (1) THE HOUSING NEEDS OF ANY MINOR CHILDREN CHILD LIVING IN THE FAMILY HOME;
- (2) THE DURATION OF THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE RESPONDENT AND ANY PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF;
 - (3) TITLE TO THE FAMILY HOME;
- (4) PENDENCY AND TYPE OF CRIMINAL CHARGES AGAINST THE RESPONDENT;
- (5) THE HISTORY AND SEVERITY OF ABUSE IN THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE RESPONDENT AND ANY PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF;
- (6) THE EXISTENCE OF ALTERNATIVE HOUSING FOR EITHER PARTY THE RESPONDENT AND ANY PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF; AND
- (7) THE FINANCIAL RESOURCES OF THE PARTIES RESPONDENT AND THE PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF.
