- (a) A copy of any order issued under this subtitle shall be served on:
  - (1) each party to the proceeding;
  - (2) the appropriate law enforcement agency; and
  - (3) any household member to whom the order applies.
- (b) (1) The court that issues an order under this subtitle may:
  - (i) direct immediate service of the order; and
  - (ii) reissue the order until service is effected.
- (2) Except in a case of alleged child abuse, the court that issues an order under this subtitle may not reissue the order more than 15 days after the date of the petitioner's initial appearance.
- (c) Return of service shall be filed with the court.] 4-508. 4-507.
- (A) EXCEPT FOR RELIEF GRANTED IN A PROTECTIVE ORDER UNDER § 4 506(D)(6), (7), AND (8) OF THIS SUBTITLE AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE COURT THAT ISSUED THE PROTECTIVE ORDER MAY MODIFY THE TERMS OF AN EXISTING ORDER DURING THE TERM OF THE ORDER AFTER NOTICE TO ALL PARTIES AND A HEARING, BUT MAY NOT EXTEND THE DURATION OF THE ORDER BEYOND THE PERIOD SPECIFIED IN § 4 506(G) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (B) AN ACTION TO MODIFY RELIEF GRANTED IN A PROTECTIVE ORDER UNDER § 4 506(D)(6), (7), AND (8) OF THIS SUBTITLE, SOLELY OR IN ADDITION TO OTHER MODIFICATIONS OF THE ORDER, SHALL BE BROUGHT EXCLUSIVELY IN THE CIRCUIT COURT.
- (C) IN A SUBSEQUENT CUSTODY, VISITATION, OR SUPPORT PROCEEDING IN A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION, THE COURT MAY CONSIDER, BUT IS NOT BOUND BY THE CUSTODY, VISITATION, OR SUPPORT DETERMINATION MADE IN THE PROTECTIVE ORDER HEARING.
- (A) (1) THE COURT THAT ISSUED THE PROTECTIVE ORDER MAY MODIFY OR RESCIND THE PROTECTIVE ORDER DURING THE TERM OF THE PROTECTIVE ORDER AFTER:
- (I) <u>GIVING NOTICE TO ALL AFFECTED PERSONS ELIGIBLE</u> FOR RELIEF AND THE RESPONDENT; AND
  - (II) A HEARING.
- (2) THE COURT MAY NOT EXTEND THE PROTECTIVE ORDER BEYOND THE PERIOD SPECIFIED IN § 4-506 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
