(1) A LAW STUDENT PRACTICING IN A CLINICAL LAW PROGRAM AT A LAW SCHOOL ACCREDITED BY THE AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION WITH THE IN COURT SUPERVISION OF A FACULTY MEMBER; OR
