

- (1) Manufacturer's license for:
  - (i) 0-499 pounds of explosives ..... [ \$25 ] \$50;
  - (ii) 500-4,999 pounds of explosives ..... [ \$50 ] \$100;
  - (iii) 5,000-9,999 pounds of explosives..... [ \$100 ] \$250;
  - (iv) 10,000 pounds or more of explosives..... [ \$150 ] \$500.
- (2) Dealer's license for:
  - (i) Retail only..... [ \$10 ] \$25;
  - (ii) Users ..... [ \$20 ] \$50;
  - (iii) Wholesale and retail..... [ \$50 ] \$100.
- (3) Storage license for:
  - (i) Class A - 500 pounds or more of explosives ..... [ \$15 ] \$50;
  - (ii) Class B - 499 pounds or less of explosives..... [ \$10 ] \$25.
- (d) The State Fire Marshal may collect a fee of [ \$10 ] \$20 for:
  - (1) Vehicle inspection of an explosive hauler; and
  - (2) Blaster's certificate.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.

**CHAPTER 68**

**(House Bill 475)**

AN ACT concerning

**Maryland State Police - Fees**

FOR the purpose of altering the fee for an initial, renewal, or subsequent handgun permit application; providing a certain exception; creating a fee for a duplicate or modified handgun permit; repealing a certain provision relating the crediting of certain fees to a special fund and the payment of certain expenses from the fund; creating a registration fee for each machine gun application filed with the Superintendent; requiring a person who makes an application to purchase or transfer certain firearms to pay a certain application fee to the dealer; requiring a dealer of certain firearms to forward the application fee to the Superintendent of the Maryland State Police; altering the application fee for an initial special police commission; altering
