- (A) Except in the calendar year it was purchased, every machine gun in this State shall be registered with the Superintendent of the Maryland State Police annually during the month of May. Also, every machine gun shall be registered within 24 hours after its acquisition. Blanks for registration shall be prepared by the Superintendent of the State Police and furnished upon application. To comply with this section the application as filed must show the make, model, serial number, caliber, type, barrel length, finish, country of origin of the gun, and the name, address, race, sex, date of birth, Maryland driver's license number, and occupation of the person in possession of the gun, from whom and the purpose for which the gun was acquired. The registration data shall not be subject to inspection by the public. Any person failing to register any gun as required by this section shall be presumed to possess the same for offensive or aggressive purpose.
- (B) EACH REGISTRATION APPLICATION FILED WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A NONREFUNDABLE REGISTRATION FEE OF \$10.

- (D) (1) A PERSON WHO MAKES AN APPLICATION TO PURCHASE OR TRANSFER A PISTOL OR REVOLVER SHALL PAY TO THE DEALER A \$10 APPLICATION FEE WITH THE APPLICATION TO PURCHASE OR TRANSFER.
- (2) THE DEALER SHALL FORWARD THE \$10 APPLICATION FEE ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE.

(b) (2) A dealer may not sell or transfer any assault weapon until the dealer [complies] AND THE PERSON MAKING AN APPLICATION TO PURCHASE OR TRANSFER COMPLY with all of the requirements for the sale or transfer of a pistol or revolver as provided for under § 442 of this article, INCLUDING PAYMENT OF THE APPLICATION FEE.

## Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments

Application for a special police commission shall be made to the Superintendent of the Maryland State Police upon such form as he prescribes. An application shall be made by the employer of the person to be commissioned and shall be required for each individual for whom a special police commission is desired. All persons to be commissioned shall be at least 18 years of age. The application shall be accompanied by a fee of [\$75] \$135 \$100 to cover the cost of investigation of the applicant. The fee is nonrefundable if the application is denied. In no case shall a fee be charged any agency of the State of Maryland, either the initial or renewal fee. Notwithstanding the above fees,
