costs paid by the Maryland State Police in securing records from any other source shall be charged to the applicant; however, the charges assessed against the applicant may not exceed the fee charged by the Federal Bureau of Investigation to the Maryland State Police for a fingerprint card record check.

4-910.

All initial commissions issued by the Governor shall be effective for a period of two (2) years from the date of issue. At the expiration of the term the commission shall be renewable for three years upon the application by the requesting agency. The application shall be in a form prescribed by the Superintendent. It shall be accompanied by a fee of [\$30] \$135 \$60 to cover the costs of renewal. The Superintendent of the State Police may prescribe a date by which applications for renewal must be submitted to him.

Article 88B - State Police

27A.

- (A) (1) THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL CHARGE A FEE TO ANY PERSON WHO REQUESTS THAT THE PERSON'S FINGERPRINTS BE TAKEN.
- (2) A FEE OF \$5 SHALL BE CHARGED FOR THE PREPARATION OF EACH FINGERPRINT CARD.
 - (3) A FEE MAY NOT BE CHARGED TO ANY PERSON WHO IS:
- (I) FINGERPRINTED AS A MATTER OF PROCEDURE IN ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTION;
- (II) REQUIRED TO HAVE FINGERPRINTS RETAKEN DUE TO ANY FAULT OR ERROR ON THE PART OF THE DEPARTMENT DURING THE PREPARATION OF THE FINGERPRINT CARD; OR
- (III) OTHERWISE DECLARED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT TO BE EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- (B) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT, THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

- (a) To qualify for certification as a security guard, an individual shall:
 - (1) meet the standards set by the Superintendent;
- (2) be an employee of or an applicant for employment with a licensed private detective agency;
