- (3) submit to the licensed private detective agency, for forwarding to the Superintendent:
- (i) a sworn application on the form the Superintendent provides; [and]
- (ii) 2 sets of fingerprint cards marked with the applicant's fingerprints; AND
 - (III) A NONREFUNDABLE APPLICATION FEE OF \$25 \$15; and
- (4) pay to the licensed private detective agency, for forwarding to the Superintendent, a records fee set by the Superintendent, not to exceed the fee that the Federal Bureau of Investigation charges the Maryland State Police for a fingerprint card record check.
- (b) On receipt from an applicant for certification as a security guard, a licensed private detective agency shall forward to the Superintendent the applicant's application form, fingerprint cards, and records fee.

- (a) (1) On receipt of an application and a [\$25] \$50 \$210 nonrefundable fee ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION from a facility for an inspection station license, the Division shall:
- $\frac{(1)}{(1)}$ Inspect the facility as to its ability to inspect and correct equipment; and
- (2) (II) If the facility is qualified, issue to it a license as an inspection station.
- (2) ON RECEIPT OF A RENEWAL APPLICATION AND A NONREFUNDABLE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION OF \$50 FOR AN INSPECTION STATION, THE DIVISION SHALL ISSUE THE RENEWAL LICENSE IF THE FACILITY IS OTHERWISE QUALIFIED.
 - (b) The license authorizes the facility to:
- (1) Inspect a used vehicle on request of its transferor or transferee and attach an inspection certificate to the vehicle;
- (2) Inspect the equipment of a vehicle for which a safety equipment repair order has been issued and issue a repair order certification for the vehicle; and
