AN ACT concerning

**Fire Inspections and Permits – Fees**

FOR the purpose of authorizing ~~certain~~ *the* counties and municipalities to adopt certain fee schedules, ordinances, and regulations for conducting certain inspections and plan reviews under certain circumstances; requiring the State Fire Prevention Commission to adopt certain regulations concerning fees for conducting certain inspections and plan reviews under certain circumstances; providing for record maintenance by certain persons and payment of certain fees by certain persons into certain funds; defining certain terms for certain purposes; providing certain exceptions; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to fire inspections, plan reviews, and fees.
