(2) THIS SUBSECTION <u>TITLE</u> APPLIES ONLY TO COUNTIES WHOSE COUNTY <u>COUNCIL OR COUNTY</u> COMMISSIONERS HAVE ADOPTED A COMPREHENSIVE NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED FIRE PREVENTION STANDARD AS A COUNTY FIRE PREVENTION CODE.

- (4) THE COUNTY <u>COUNCIL OR COUNTY</u> COMMISSIONERS OF A COUNTY QUALIFIED UNDER <u>PARAGRAPH</u> (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION § 5–102 <u>OF THIS TITLE</u> MAY ADOPT ORDINANCES OR REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH AND ADMINISTER A FEE SCHEDULE FOR CONDUCTING:
- (I) <u>INSPECTIONS AND</u> PLAN REVIEWS TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE COUNTY FIRE PREVENTION CODE; AND
- (II) INSPECTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
