- (b) (1) The term of a member is 4 years.
- (2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the [Commission] ADVISORY COUNCIL as of July 1, 1982. The terms of those members end as follows:
 - (i) 4 in 1983;
 - (ii) 4 in 1984;
 - (iii) 3 in 1985; and
 - (iv) 5 in 1986.
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (5) A member who serves 2 consecutive full 4-year terms may not be reappointed for 4 years after the completion of those terms.
- (6) If a vacancy occurs, the Governor promptly shall appoint a successor. 13-204.
 - (a) The members present at a meeting are a quorum to do business.
- (b) The [Commission] ADVISORY COUNCIL shall meet at least twice a year, at the times and places that it determines.
 - (c) A member of the [Commission] ADVISORY COUNCIL:
 - (1) May not receive compensation; but
- (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
- (d) [In accordance with the State budget, the Commission may employ a staff, including:
 - (1) An executive director;
 - (2) An assistant; and
- (3) A secretary-stenographer] THE SECRETARY SHALL DESIGNATE THE STAFF NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE.

The [Commission] ADVISORY COUNCIL:

(1) Shall develop and promote educational programs in the prevention and treatment of high blood pressure and related cardiovascular risk factors; and
